The genesis of the ROJM project

ROJM project was based on the previous experience of another project „Roma i Gadziowie na jednym podwórku”.

The project implemented in 2010-2011 was funded by the European Union under the Human Capital Operational Programme.

The activities were carried out by the Municipality of Wrocław (CIRS and MOPS) and social partners: the Foundation for Social Integration PROM and In Posterum Foundation.



163 Roma benefited from:

- Vocational courses (catering, repair and construction, driver's license) - 48 people – including 32 women.
- Polish language courses - 40 people.
- Workshops on skills everyday - 40 people.
- Workshop for leaders of Roma - 4 pers.
- Counseling - 40 people.
- White Days - 50 people.
- Legal counseling, social
- Education and health - 76 pers.



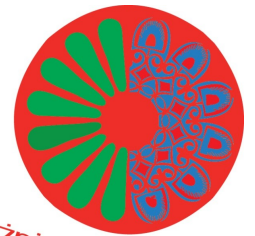
All activities for the Roma have been supported:

- educational activities for public administration in the field of Roma culture and work with this group (76 pers.)
- promoting awareness of Roma among the society of the majority - Roma Cultural Film Festival



Main aim of the project

The increase in the level of social integration of the 180 Roma people in Wrocław during IX.2012-X.2014r. by providing specialist counseling, professional activation and strengthening professional competence of 70 representatives from institutions and organizations working for the Roma community.

Detailed objectives of the project

- Raising the level of education and social awareness of the Roma through legal, social, health and educational counseling.
- Increasing the educational potential of Roma children through specialized educational support.
- Improving employment potential of the Roma in Wrocław.
- Strengthening professional competence of 70 public services and NGOs representatives from Wrocław.

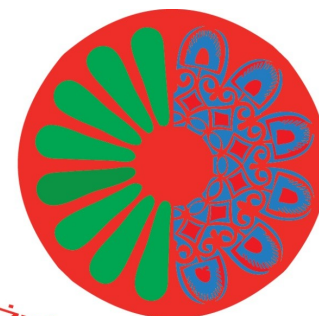
Target groups

- Roma people: 100 females i 80 males, 30 children (15 girls, 15 boys)
- 70 public service and non-governmental organizations employees.

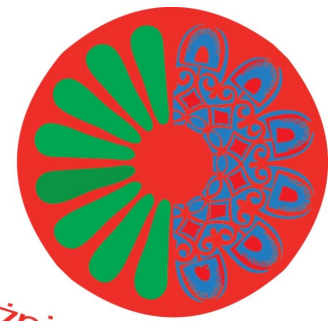
